Touring London, Dinner Cruise

June 8, 2022, Wednesday Windsor Castle & Eton

No trip to London should be without a visit to Windsor Castle! After a delicious breakfast, we venture out of London to discover the historic towns of Windsor and Eton. The largest and oldest occupied fortress in the world, Windsor Castle, is a most impressive vision of the battlements and towers used for state occasions as well as the Queen's weekend retreat. Windsor Castle takes center stage and its massive bulk and heavy presence dominate the twin towns of Windsor and



Eton. With its romantic architecture, this is a "must-see". Across the River Thames, we find ourselves surrounded by Eton College, a different flavor to Windsor Castle. Eton has produced 19 British Prime Ministers and among other former pupils are Prince William and his brother Harry, Percy Shelly, and George Orwell. We will have plenty of time for a leisurely lunch and to check out the pretty and cozy local shops prior to returning to the center of London in the late afternoon. The evening is yours to enjoy at leisure. We recommend a stroll along the Jubilee Walkway, the official walking route opened in 1977 to commemorate Queen Elizabeth II's accession. B

June 9, 2022, Thursday A day at leisure

Breakfast at your own pace and a day at leisure to explore and find your favorite spot of London. Julie, our tour guide, is available in the morning hours to assist you with ideas and how to best utilize this day on your own. Visit one of the trendy food markets, stroll Notting Hill and Portobello market, Primrose Hill and Camden Town market, St. Kathrine Docks Marina, Greenwich village (the Royal Observatory is the site of the Greenwich meridian line), or simply "shop till you drop" ... the included Oyster Card makes it easy and fast to navigate London. You may also choose to join Julie on a 4-hour guided tour of the Victoria and Albert Museum highlighting the fashion, theatre, and jewelry galleries of this amazing museum. The tour ends at Harrods (time on your own). Tonight's "Farewell London" dinner includes a stroll across the Tower Bridge and along the south side of the Thames through the Dickensian alleyways and warehouses of Shad Thames (weather permitted) before dinner is served overlooking the river. June 12, 2022, Sunday Montmartre Walk & Art Class

After a filling breakfast, we transfer to the picturesque neighborhood of the "Mountain of the Martyr"; Montmartre. It owes its name to the martyrdom of Saint Denis, who was decapitated on the hill around 250 AD. Saint Denis was the Bishop of Paris and is the patron saint of France. With its cobbled streets, stunning Sacré-Coeur Basilica, artists, bistros ...Montmartre is full of charm! Perched on the top of a small hill, the most famous Parisian district has lost none of its village atmosphere that appealed so much to the artists of the 19th and 20th centuries. A real melting pot of art, and art is exactly what we are going to focus on this morning. We divide ourselves into two smaller groups, and while half of us walk the neighborhood to learn the inspiring history, the other half will be introduced to making your own sketchbook. You are provided with a high-quality moleskin notebook, some pens, and maybe a French beret, and our teacher will share her own private travel books for your inspiration. After a good hour, we switch. But you get to keep your notebook and can continue your drawings as you enjoy the days in Paris. Our excursion today ends with lunch before we are off to an afternoon and evening at leisure. Optional afternoon class: Become a perfumer's apprentice and create your own personal Eau de Cologne! It is an unforgettable, fun and sensory experience, centered on the creation of a fragrance based on aromatic notes of citrus and orange flower. The duration of the class is 90 minutes and is led by a perfumery expert. After the workshop, you will head home with your creation presented in an elegant, personalized 100 ml bottle and pouch, a signed diploma, and your perfumer's apprentice apron. B | L



June 13, 2022, Monday Louvre & the Opera

Followed by a hearty breakfast, it's time to visit the Louvre Museum and the Opera.
