

From Munich to Prague

Dear Friends,

Executive Travel is excited to have secured a set of 20 tickets to the unique Passion Play in June of 2022. This trip is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity as the Passion Play is held only every ten years.

The small village of Oberammergau sprawls along the pretty Ammer River valley in the alpine region of Upper Bavaria, and the Ammergau mountains look down on a settlement that has grown steadily since its inhabitants first performed their world-renowned Passion Play in 1634.

Nearly 400 years ago the plague raged in many parts of Europe and did not spare Oberammergau. The villagers promised to perform the suffering, death, and resurrection of Christ every tenth year, in hopes that no one would die of the plague anymore. They were answered by God and therefore, in 1634, the first Passion Play took place and the promise has been kept until today! Male actors start growing their beards 15 months beforehand, and even the local policemen are allowed to ignore a regulation that normally keeps them clean-shaven. Choir practice starts in November the year before. The Passion Play is one of the most breathtaking performances you will ever experience!

But our journey in June will visit more than the Passion Play and Oberammergau! We start in the Bavarian capital of Munich, home to centuryold buildings and numerous museums. And what is Munich without a visit to the famed Hofbräuhaus, the amazing beer hall founded in 1589? A delightful meal here is included in the tour program.

Neuschwanstein Castle that inspired Disney's Sleeping Beauty, and Salzburg is on our map and we will be enjoying a tour of Mondsee and "The Sound of Music" region. Shop for local souvenirs and learn all about Mozart, before we continue to elegant Vienna, known to music-lovers as the birthplace of the waltz and also home to the stunning Lipizzan horses at the Spanish Riding School. Our journey ends in Prague, a reallife fairy tale city, where we will explore the picturesque streets and historical sites. This trip is led and guided by our handpicked and favorite tour guide, Gunther Bachhuber, who will meet us upon our arrival in Munich and travel alongside all the way to Prague.

Others are more contemporary but all display a skill that reflects 500 years of tradition. The Play begins in the afternoon and is approximately seven hours long. Dinner is included and will be served during the three-hour intermission. After the play, we return to our hotel to reflect on this amazing performance. June 11, 2022 Saturday, Salzburg

Wednesday, Vienna - Prague

Our morning begins with a visit to the world-famous Spanish Riding School with the stunning Lipizzaner horses. Here they demonstrate the haute école ("high school") movements of classical dressage, including the highly controlled, stylized jumps and other movements known as the "airs above the ground."



Our second stop today is in České Budějovice, the capital of South Bohemia. Elegant townhouses gather around one of the largest squares in Europe, an idyllic salt store and a brewery, cooking up the original Budvar beer; the Budweiser! It is time to savor the city's pleasant atmosphere with a tankard of the world-famous beer. We reach the "City of a Hundred Spires", Prague, in the afternoon for an evening at leisure. B

June 16, 2022 Thursday, Prague

Today is dedicated to majestic and mysterious Prague! One of the most beautiful capital cities in Europe, steeped in castles, cathedrals and medieval squares. and visually stunning from every angle. The cobbled lanes and preserved architecture are globally renowned, and unlike many Eastern European cities, Prague was largely spared the demolition of World War II. The city was merely a province in the Austro-Hungarian empire, and mostly managed to avoid being rebuilt during the 18th and 19th centuries. The resulting abundance of Barogue, Gothic, and Renaissance architecture makes the city a kind of open-air museum, especially around the Old Town area. We will experience it all, including a stroll across the historic Charles Bridge to visit the city's most



impressive sight: the UNESCO World Heritage site, Prague Castle. Don't miss the traditional sweet "trdelnik" baked at every corner. Prague will take your breath away - guaranteed! We enjoy a farewell dinner tonight in a local restaurant. B | D
