July 8, 2023, Saturday

Depart from your hometown and take an overnight flight across the Atlantic to Copenhagen. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as we start our European adventure.

July 9, 2023, Sunday

Upon arrival in Copenhagen, our local guide will meet us at the airport and escort us by private transfer to our city center hotel. Following time to freshen up, we will head out for a city sightseeing tour by bike. Included are the historical center, the harbor area, and a guided tour of Copenhill (Copenhagen's epicenter for urban mountain sport.) We will enjoy a leisurely lunch at "Reffen," an open-air street-food delight. If you are still energized, we suggest a by-night canal tour. Estimated miles by bike: 7.

July 10, 2023, Monday

Enjoy breakfast at your own pace, and then take a day to enjoy everything Copenhagen has to offer. This city is one of Europe's most vibrant and trendy capitals. We recommend you take a canal tour, visit the beautiful amusement park, Tivoli, walk the world's longest shopping and pedestrian street, "Strøget," peoplewatch from a local café, visit the Royal Palace of Rosenborg, enjoy life along



the quay of Nyhavn ...the possibilities are endless. One thing is for sure: you will love Copenhagen. Dinner tonight is served at a local restaurant within walking distance from our hotel.

July 11, 2023, Tuesday

Enjoy breakfast. We will adjust our bikes and head out on our Northern Zealand adventure. Cycling through Copenhagen is a fantastic way to start our bike tour. We pass some famous sights such as the Little Mermaid and the renowned beach "Bellevue." In Dyrehaven, the Royal hunting grounds, you will cycle on peaceful paths surrounded by century-old trees and curious deer. We will stop for lunch at a local bike café and then visit "Bakken," the oldest amusement park in the world, before reaching our hotel in Rungsted on the coast of Øresund. Enjoy an evening stroll at Rungsted Marina; there are plenty of local restaurants to enjoy dinner, or visit Rungstedlund, the home of the Danish author Karen Blixen (world-famous for "Out of Africa"); it's next door! Estimated miles by bike: 23. B|L

July 12, 2023 Wednesday

We will enjoy a laidback breakfast. Then, head out to bike along the coastal road to the Louisiana Museum of Modern Art. We

We enjoy the exhibition (you will love the museum shop!), and lunch is served at the museum restaurant. We continue our adventure along the bike trails through small villages until we reach Helsingør, our home for the next two nights. After an easy day on the bike, you might wish to spend the afternoon visiting the old borough with the impressive Kronborg Castle (the castle from Shakespeare's play "Hamlet"). You will love Helsingør's cobblestoned streets, local shops, and restaurants. Visit the Maritime Museum, and don't forget to swing by the Brostrade Ice cream shop (top it up with whipped cream and homemade jam.)

Estimated miles by bike: 15. B | L

July 13, 2023, Thursday

After a hearty breakfast, we will cross by ferry (20 minutes) to Helsingborg, Sweden. Our local guides will take us on a city tour, including a visit to Sct. Maria Church. Take in Sweden at your own pace, bike along the coastal road to Mölle (20 miles each way) to discover the scenic harbor and the beautiful Kullaberg Nature Resort. You can also relax at Fredriksdal Open Air Museum. In the late afternoon, we return to Helsingør by ferry. Dinner is served at our beautiful resort hotel. Estimated miles by bike: 10 (or 50 if you head to Mölle, Sweden). B | D



July 14, 2023, Friday

Enjoy breakfast. Today starts with a visit to Kronborg Castle (guided tour). Immortalized as "Elsinore" in William Shakespeare's play Hamlet, Kronborg is one of the most important Renaissance castles in Northern Europe and was inscribed on UNESCO's World Heritage List in 2000. We continue through the picturesque landscape of Northern Zealand, through small villages, to Fredensborg. We will be staying next door to the Royal Palace of Fredensborg, the spring and autumn residence of HRH Queen Margrethe II. We will tour (by foot) the Royal Gardens of Fredensborg Castle. The castle was built by King Christian IV in the early 17th century and is the largest Renaissance complex in the Nordic region. The aim of the building was to show off and enhance Christian IV's status as a powerful European monarch. Dinner tonight is served at our hotel. Estimated miles by bike: 15. B | D

July 15, 2023, Saturday

Breakfast is enjoyed at our own pace before we pay a visit to Fredensborg Castle. Lunch is served at the castle restaurant; we will say a fond farewell to our tour guides today. Then, we start our journey to Copenhagen. Heading south, we pass lovely forests, beautiful scenery, and wetlands rich with birdlife.



We will bike to Hillerød Station, then board

the local train to Hellerup. From here, we

will bike the last few miles to our hotel in

the center of Copenhagen. We will cycle

through Nørrebro, one of the most colorful

neighborhoods in Copenhagen. You

must slow down and be aware of all the

cyclists heading toward the city. This is

one of the busiest bicycle neighborhoods

in Denmark. We are arriving at our hotel

in the late afternoon for an evening at

leisure. You will keep your bikes (the hotel

will store them safely away) for the next

two days' leisurely adventures (without

tour guides). Estimated miles by bike: 15.



Get lost in the narrow alleys, enjoy a meal at the harbor, bike along the seaside ...what's not to love?! B

July 17, 2023, Monday

One last day to enjoy your vacation. Ride out* and enjoy the city and the locals! If you are looking for a great route outside the center, then head to Lyngby and Brede (there is a lovely bistro in Brede) and return through Klampenborg and Hellerup. Beautiful scenery, great bike paths, and many shops and cafés along the way. The route is approximately 25 miles. B

July 16, 2023, Sunday

Sleep in this morning, kick back, relax, and unwind. Breakfast is served until late! Today, enjoy the day in Copenhagen. You have your bike at your disposal*, and we suggest you take a tour to Amager Strand, and from there, continue behind the airport to the quaint village of Dragør (9 miles each way) founded in the 1100s as a fishing village, and used as a fishing port for centuries. It has a Dutch influence because the Danish king invited Dutch farmers to live in the area to supply food for the royal family in the 16th century. The Dutch were more agriculturally advanced than the Danish, and they actually introduced carrots to Denmark.

July 18, 2023, Tuesday

All too soon, our journey has ended. Morning transfer to Copenhagen airport in plenty of time to check in for our flight and clear security. You may do some lastminute shopping at the duty-free shops before boarding and flying west across the Atlantic Ocean, back to the United States. Arrival to your home airport tonight.

Tour Activity Level:

Moderate, guided bike and hotel tour. This is not an arduous tour however there are some hills on the route but you have all day to do the cycling. The traffic on the route should be quite light. You should, however, cycle carefully at all times, especially when going downhill or during any rain showers.

This is not a tour for inexperienced cyclists. This tour offers our own Englishspeaking tour guides and support crew. You will be given route descriptions and maps, so you may ride and explore on your own each day or ride along with our guides.

About E-Bikes:

While e-bikes provide a wonderful option to keep bicycling accessible, they take practice. An e-bike is heavier than your hybrid bike causing some to fall if you are not used to riding an e-bike. Those familiar and experienced with e-bikes are good candidates for our trip.

Our guides will be available to assist with repairs.

For a smooth start each morning, please ensure you take the bike tagged with your first and last name to avoid any unnecessary mix-ups. Never leave your bike unattended, especially in the towns along the route. We recommend that you do not take your bike with you when sightseeing or during a walking tour through any city. For damage other than a tire puncture, please contact the tour guides. Please do not have any repairs done on the rental bikes without the tour guides' consent.

The bicycle always needs to be locked when unattended and the included Bike Protection does not cover the theft of the bicycle while it is unlocked.

Shipping your own bike(s)!

We recommend that you utilize the provided bikes, but should you wish to bring you own, please be aware of the following:

There is a limit of 2 bikes per airplane. The cost is estimated at \$250 per bike per way, (e-bikes or larger bikes may be charged differently). Please contact Executive Travel if you need further information. Note: We may refer you directly to the airline.

You can also choose to ship your bike(s) in advance. Be aware that prices may be as high as \$800 per way to ship your bike(s) to an airport.

5 business days are required for delivery to Copenhagen airport and you should be aware that dropping off the bike for the return to the United States can be done during weekdays only (we return from Denmark on a Tuesday).
