### Dear Ladies.



# **July 27, 2024 - Saturday** Traveling to Vancouver

Our wonderful adventure begins as we fly to Vancouver, where we will spend our first two nights. We will meet with our local tour guide upon arrival and transfer to our hotel. Vancouver is one of North America's most beautiful and cosmopolitan cities, dazzled with views of the Pacific Ocean, majestic mountains, and a glittering skyline. Check in, enjoy dinner, relax, and unwind. D

# July 28, 2024 - Sunday Vancouver Island - Victoria

We will enjoy breakfast and then head out for a ferry ride (approximately 90 minutes) through the scenic Gulf Islands to Vancouver Island. Upon arrival, we will visit the world-famous Butchart Gardens to stroll among fifty acres of floral gardens, fountains, and meandering paths. Designated a National Historic Site of Canada, these are some of the world's prettiest gardens. Next, we will visit Victoria, British Columbia's beautiful capital. Here we will enjoy a Victoria City Tour featuring the Inner Harbor, the imposing Parliament Building constructed in 1897, and views of the famous Empress Hotel. You will have a bit of leisure time to take in the city's turn-of-the-century Victorian charm or shop in the downtown heritage district. In the late afternoon, we will return to Vancouver by ferry. # July 29, 2024 - Monday Vancouver Sightseeing - VIA Rail

After a hearty breakfast, we will enjoy a Vancouver city sightseeing, including Stanley Park, famous for its colorful Indian totem poles, Chinatown & Gastown, Vancouver's turn-of-thecentury pedestrian mall lined with shops and restaurants along cobblestone streets. In the afternoon, we will board VIA Rail's train, The Canadian, for an unforgettable two-day and overnight rail excursion into the aweinspiring Canadian Rockies. We will explore the train before settling into our comfortable berth in the Sleeper Plus Train Car for the evening. The berths feature seats that convert to upper and lower beds for sleeping. Each 20-passenger Sleeper Plus Train Car features washrooms and a shower. Dinner is included, along with exclusive access to the Park Car for panoramic views. Oh, what fun! B|Ď

### July 30, 2024 - Tuesday Jasper National Park - Maligne Lake

Breakfast is served onboard the train while The Canadian winds along the North Thompson River, pass towering peaks and glacial valleys in a vast wilderness once only accessible by rail. Enjoy the views of the incredible passing scenery like Mt. Robson, the highest peak in the Canadian Rockies. We will cross the Continental Divide into Alberta, arriving in Jasper for a one-night stay. This afternoon, we will discover Jasper



scenery consists of carefully protected ecosystems and is a photographer's paradise; cameras out, Ladies! We will pay a visit to Maligne Canyon, a Jasper landmark. Next, watch for wildlife as you drive to see the crystal blue waters of Maligne Lake, the largest natural lake in the Canadian Rockies. We will arrive at our hotel in Jasper in the late afternoon for an evening at leisure. B

### **July 31, 2024 - Wednesday** Icefields Parkway - Banff

After a filling breakfast, we will travel south along the Icefields Parkway, linking Jasper and Lake Louise, one of North America's most spectacular drives. We will travel the road as it winds between snow-domed peaks and immense hanging glaciers; you may see elk, deer, bighorn sheep, or bears. We will stop to see the raw power of the Athabasca Falls. A short paved trail will take you to the falls and the waterfall, and its gorge can be admired from several fenced viewpoints along the trail. Later, we will ride in a specially designed Ice Explorer on the 1000-foot thick Athabasca Glacier part of the Columbia Icefield, one of the largest ice masses outside the Arctic Circle. We continue into Banff National Park and will arrive at our hotel in the quaint town of Banff for a three-night stay. Dinner at the hotel, and the evening is yours to enjoy Banff. The vibrant downtown streets are filled with unique restaurants and souvenir shops. B | D



# August 1, 2024 - Thursday Yoho National Park - Lake Louise

Breakfast is served before we head out to view two of the crown jewels of the Canadian Rockies. We will stop to view spectacular Moraine Lake and the Valley of the Ten Peaks before visiting the Chateau Lake Louise, located within a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Capture breathtaking views and photos of Lake Louise and Victoria Glacier. Then we travel through Kicking Horse Pass into Yoho National Park to see the Natural Bridge and the remarkable Spiral Tunnels and cross the Continental Divide before returning to Banff. This evening is yours to relax. B

# August 2, 2024 - Friday Touring Banff

This morning, we will enjoy a Banff area tour, including Mt. Rundle, Bow Falls (a must-see when visiting Banff - walk along the trail to the top of the rushing waterfalls), and Tunnel Mountain, an excellent place to take photos and gaze over the town of Banff and down the Bow Valley. Later, you can explore Banff and the surroundings on your own. If you like to hike, the Hoodoos Trail measures 3 miles one-way and is considered an easy-going trail. The route enjoys an elevation gain of only 100 meters and should take between 3 and 4 hours to complete. We will gather to enjoy a farewell dinner with our fellow travelers in the Banff area. BID

# Train Accommodations Sleeper Plus Class Berths

Passengers are accommodated in upper & lower berths in the Sleeper Plus Class, which includes onboard meals & sleeping accommodations.

During the day, the berths feature couch-style seats facing each other with a window. At night, the seats convert to upper & lower beds with heavy private curtains for sleeping.

Breakfast is included, along with exclusive access to the Park Car with its lounges and 360-degree panoramic views.

Each Sleeper Plus Car features public washrooms, shower facilities (1), and accommodates up to 20 quests.



The Canadian Train departs Vancouver at 3:00 PM on July 29 and arrives in July at 11:00 AM on July 30. The train schedule is subject to change & local rail traffic conditions. The Canadian Train is owned and operated by VIA Rail Canada.
