

#### September 4, 2024, Wednesday Traverse City - Mackinac Island

### September 6, 2024, Friday Mackinac Island

Breakfast is served! Today, let your imagination run wild, a full day in stunning Mackinac Island to do as you wish. The day is free to enjoy and explore the quaint town and its simple life. Eighty percent of Mackinac Island is parkland, and if a golf cart is too modern for you, how about getting around by horse and buggy or by a rented bike? Don't forget to swing by one (or more!) of the 13 fudge shops downtown. More than 10,000 pounds of

fudge is slabbed daily on marble, allowing the fudge to cool evenly and quickly giving it a unique flavor and creating a great show too. Or visit the fascinating butterfly conservatory, the Wings of Mackinac, to watch the butterflies eat dried fruits and nectar. A lovely experience!

Maybe you prefer to take a carriage tour (tickets provided) which is a fantastic way to see the sites, make mental notes on where to eat and shop, and get a general lay of the land. Your coachman will share historical information as well as information about your new horse friends. Your tour may stop at Arch Rock, where you will see the most beautiful view of the lake through the arch. The Fort is located at the tip-top of a high hill, so this may be a good time to take advantage of the Fort tour if you like. Check to see if you can hop off at Fort Mackinac if you would like to. Then you may catch a tour carriage (based on space available) back down toward our hotel. Enjoy a beautiful evening at leisure. B

# September 7, 2024, Saturday Farewell Mackinac - Ahoy Harbor Springs

After the ferry arrives back at Mackinaw City, we will board our motorcoach and head off for the stunning lakeside community of Harbor Springs for lunch and an afternoon of shopping.
