March 20, 2025 - Thursday Traveling to Munich

Our wonderful adventure begins as we meet at St. Mark's United Methodist Church's parking lot. A private motorcoach will transfer us to Omaha airport where we will take an overnight flight to Munich. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you start your dream vacation.

March 21, 2025 - Friday Munich

Welcome to Munich! Upon arrival, we will meet our private tour guide, who will accompany us in Germany and during our days in the Czech Republic. Munich is a beautiful city contrasting high-tech modernity and proud old traditions and has so many fantastic attractions that it is hard to know where to start. It is also a city of royal scandals and a turbulent 20th century with the early days of the Nazi Party. We transfer to the center of the city to take a walking tour of Altstadt (old town), including Marienplatz with the famous Glockenspiel and the Viktualien-markt where you will find delightful stalls selling local delicacies, exotic fruits, flowers and plants, local crafts, and much more. Lunch is served at a beautiful restaurant located opposite the State Opera House. Check in to our hotel in the early afternoon and have an evening to relax and unwind. B (during flight) | L

March 22, 2025 - Saturday

BMW World - Regensburg - Embarkation

After a rich breakfast, we head out to experience the BMW World. Whether you're a die-hard enthusiast or simply curious, BMW World promises an unforgettable journey through the past, present, and future of automotive excellence. Next stop is Regensburg, a medieval UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Germany's oldest towns. Crusaders used the 12th-century stone bridge to cross the Danube en route to the Holy Land. We have arranged an old-town sightseeing on foot, and you will have leisurely time for lunch. Try the historic "Wurstkuchl" (Sausage Kitchen). Located in a 900-year-old building, this is the world's oldest sausage kitchen, still serving more than 6,000 sausages to its guests daily. The menu is simple: Sausages (comes in portions of six, eight, or ten!) along with sauerkraut and mustard! In the late afternoon, we will reach Vilshofen. This is where we embark on nothing less than a fairy tale cruise and journey down the Danube. We will meet the crew and check into our beautifully decorated cabins, and later, we will enjoy a delightful dinner. Welcome on board! B | D





March 23, 2025 - Sunday Vilshofen - Passau

Explore Vilshofen's beautiful old town before cruising to Passau, nestled at the confluence of three rivers in southeastern Germany - a picturesque city with a rich history and captivating charm. Known as the "City of Three Rivers," Passau is where the Danube, Inn, and IIz rivers meet, creating a stunning natural spectacle. Its history dates back over two millennia, with evidence of settlement from Roman times. The city boasts a blend of architectural styles, including Baroque, Gothic, and Renaissance, showcased in its churches, palaces, and narrow cobblestone streets. Join a walking tour, or if you prefer to be more active, hike high into the hills for a visit to the "Veste Oberhaus," Passau's Castle Hill; or how about a River Inn bike tour? B | L | D

March 24, 2025 - Monday Linz

We arrive in Linz, where you will have several choices of excursions. For those who love The Sound of Music, enjoy a fullday excursion to Salzburg and tour the historic center, Mirabell Gardens, Residenz Square, and the Old Market. You may also choose to join a full-day excursion to the charming Czech mountain town of Český Krumlov, where you can stroll its cobblestone streets, marvel at the city's picturesque Baroque and Renaissance-style buildings, and tour Krumlov Castle, one of Europe's largest castle complexes. Following the excursions, you may also choose to take a brief walking tour in Linz. Alternatively, join a walking tour through the old city center of Linz and by the Mozart House, or bike along the city's famed "Cultural Mile" and the Danube. B | L | D

March 25, 2025 - Tuesday Dürnstein - Weissenkirchen



March 26, 2025 - Wednesday Vienna

March 27, 2025 - Thursday Bratislava

Bratislava Castle, perched atop a hill, offers panoramic cityscape views. Host to the crowning ceremonies of 11 Hungarian kings and queens between 1536 and 1830, Bratislava certainly has earned the title "Coronation City of Kings," as you will discover during your walking tour. Or, join a special "Tastes of Slovakia" tour. For a more active adventure, hike up to Bratislava Castle, offering magnificent views of the city. B | L | D

March 28, 2025 - Friday Budapest

Today, you have the opportunity to visit both the Buda (hilly) and Pest (flat) sides of the Danube River. Start on the Buda side, following your guide through the city's Castle District where you will marvel at the fairytale turrets of Fisherman's Bastion, gaze upon the breathtaking panorama below and see Matthias Church, renowned for its striking tower and colorful mosaic roof. For a more active tour, hike to Budapest's Castle Hill. In the afternoon, explore the treasures of Pest, admiring the colossal Hungarian Parliament Building, Heroes' Square and the moving "Shoes on the Danube Bank" memorial. B | L | D





March 29, 2025 - Sunday Disembarkation - Prague

After breakfast, we will disembark and meet with our local tour guide and private motorcoach to start our journey toward Prague. Beer has a long and illustrious history in the Czech Republic, with the first brewery known to have existed in 993. We will make a stop in Budvar, the hometown to the Budweiser beer, for lunch. 


