Traveling to Portugal

Our Portuguese adventure begins as we take an overnight flight to Porto. Enjoy inflight entertainment and meal service as you embark on a dream vacation.

June 15, 2025 - Sunday Porto

Welcome to Porto! Upon arrival, we meet our private tour guide and take a short drive to the city's center. We will enjoy a panoramic orientation tour of a town so pretty that it is almost unreal. The secondlargest city in Portugal will welcome you with its picturesque charm of winding streets, steep staircases, azulejo-tiled buildings, and beautiful bridges. Lunch is served in our favorite local restaurant. Take a stroll along the Douro River this afternoon to prepare for a good night's rest at our beautiful hotel, located right on the river. June 16, 2025 - Monday Minho Region - Guimarães

After an enjoyable breakfast, we will board our motor coach and head out to visit a Barrosã cattle breeding farm. Portugal is home to several native cattle breeds, each adapted to the diverse landscapes and climates of the country. Barrosã is a rustic breed from northern Portugal, particularly the Minho region, known for its high-quality meat. Lunch today is served at the farm before we take a short drive to the city of Guimarães, a UNESCO World Heritage Site considered the cradle and birthplace of the Portuguese nation. Guimarães is known for its well-preserved medieval buildings and the 10th-century Guimarães Castle with sweeping city views. We will stroll this enchanting town to see the numerous historical sites, including the convent of Santa Clara, which



today functions as the town hall. Pottery is one of the most interesting arts in the city's long tradition of purely rustic craft and has existed since the 13th century. Also, most people don't know that the Guimarães region is considered one of the most luxurious linens manufacturers. We return to Porto in the late afternoon to enjoy an evening at leisure. B | L

June 17, 2025 - Tuesday

Porto - Douro River Cruise & Winery Visit Today, we will head out to explore the beautiful, mysterious, and captivating Porto. Figure out what makes Porto such a remarkable and special city. We will experience the Luis I Bridge, a double-deck metal arch bridge that spans the Douro River. The São Francisco church is known for its lavish Baroque interior with ornate and glorious leaf carvings. It is one of the city's most beautiful churches. Next door is the Palacio da Bolsa (the Stock Exchange Palace), a historic building, once part of the St. Francis Convent, founded in the 13th century. We will also pass by Casa do Infante, the ancient customs house and the old residence of the Kings of Portugal's senior officials. On the northern side of the Douro River is the City of Ribeira, and on the southern side is the Vila Nova de Gaia, where we will find the world-famous port wine houses. We will stop to sip and delight in the world's most famous fortified wine. Free time for lunch before we take a drive along the Douro River to a local winery. It's time to taste Portuguese wine! Later, we will embark on a private boat to cruise the river and enjoy some of the most outstanding sceneries in the world. Dinner is served at our hotel tonight. B | T | D

cooperage, where we will learn about the art and process of making casks used for wine and whisky storage. Our second stop is Aveiro, also nicknamed "Portuguese Venice," distinguished by its network of canals with colorful boats, the "moliceiros," set along the Ria de Aveiro lagoon. Aveiro is strong in salt, and we will learn about the salt harvesting traditions and the region's tight connection to the sea. An educational tour through Aveiro's salt ponds will provide you with this ancient activity's history, traditions, and secrets. Free time for lunch before we drive to Coimbra. Prior to arriving at our unique accommodation, we will make a stop to enjoy coffee and "cruzio," the local pastry made with eggs and almonds. Dinner is served at our beautiful castle hotel. B|T|D

June 19, 2025 - Thursday Coimbra - Tomar

Today, we will take a tour of Coimbra and its university, the oldest in Portugal (and one of the oldest in the world), built on the grounds of a former palace famed for its baroque library. It holds 60 thousand books, dating from the 16th century to the 18th century, on a wide variety of topics that can still be consulted today. Coimbra is the former capital and home to a preserved medieval old town that, to our benefit, isn't overrun by tourists. Free time for lunch. We will take a short one-hour drive to Tomar. A sleepy town at first glance, but don't let that fool you; Tomar is incredibly pretty. We will visit Tomar Castle and Convent of Christ, the area's shining jewels. Do you remember the religious, military order mentioned in the Da Vinci Code? When visiting Tomar, Dan Brown fans and history buffs interested in the Knights Templar can add to their fun by searching for Templar secrets. The convent and castle complex is a historical and cultural monument and was listed as a UNESCO World Heritage site in Monsaraz - Wine like nowhere Else!

June 20, 2025 - Friday

Olives & Cork

Today, we will tour of an olive oil-producing farm to learn about the process of extracting the finest qualities of oil. Our visit includes a tasting of the "golden drops." Our next stop is at Montado, a cork tree plantation. We will start in the forest. Cork oaks are harvested every nine years once they reach maturity. It doesn't harm the tree, and the cork bark regrows. An average of 90 to 130 Ibs of cork is harvested from each cork oak. After the harvest, the tree itself is marked and numbered so that future harvesters will know that particular tree needs nine years before it is harvested again. Free time for lunch before we head further south to Evora, where we will spend the next two nights. This museum city, whose roots go back to Roman times, reached its golden age in the 15th century when it became the residence of the Portuguese kings. Its unique quality stems from the whitewashed houses decorated with azulejos (tiles) and wrought-iron balconies dating from the 16th to the 18th century. Its monuments profoundly influenced Portuguese architecture in Brazil, and the city of Evora became a UNESCO World Heritage Site and open-air museum in 1986. Dinner is served at our unique hotel, a former convent. Welcome to Evora! B | D

June 21, 2025 - Saturday

Evora - Wine - Monsaraz

Our day starts with a tour of Evora, including a visit to the Church of St. Francis and the Chapel of the Bones (scary? You judge!). Our lunch today is served in a very special winery. We promise you nothing but a very



unique experience. Only four places in the world still make wine this way. Our last stop is in the village of Monsaraz, probably the most beautiful monument village in Portugal: mysterious castle streets, the view over Alqueva Lake... Monsaraz is magical. And the bottom of the lake keeps yet another secret ...and we will taste it! We will return to our beautiful hotel for dinner and a relaxing evening. B | T | L | D

June 22, 2025 - Sunday Lisbon

After a hearty breakfast, it's time to say goodbye to Evora and head to Lisbon (a short 90-minute drive). Upon arrival, we will take a tour of the highlights of Lisbon. Visit the famous landmarks such as Rossio Square, the Baixa quarter's main squares, the grand Avenida da Liberdade, Pombal Square, and stop for pictures of Belem Tower. We will also visit the Monument of the Discoverer and Jeronimos Monastery (we will visit the church) with the tomb of Vasco da Gama. We will check into our centrally located hotel in the late afternoon. The evening is at leisure. B

June 23, 2025 - Monday Sintra - Cascais

After a relaxing breakfast, we will head out to visit Sintra, one of the world's most alluring towns. Enchanting palaces, historical fortifications, and enigmatic pathways occupy the hilltop and slope of this town. We will visit the National Palace, which, for more than 1,000 years, has presided over the town center. Notable for its white facade, conical chimneys, and intricately tiled chapel, this house-museum is one of Portugal's best-preserved medieval royal residences. Lunch is served in a local restaurant. We will make a stop in Cascais, the premier holiday destination of the Portuguese Riviera before we return to our hotel for an evening on our own. B | L



June 24, 2025 - Tuesday Lisbon

Enjoy breakfast at your own pace. We will meet to take a fun tuk-tuk ride through the historic neighborhoods of Lisbon. While the tuk-tuk is not a traditional means of transport in Lisbon, or Portugal for that matter, it is a very efficient vehicle for getting around the steep and narrow streets. The remainder of the day is at leisure. Stroll the cobblestone alleys, visit some of Lisbon's new "niche museums," explore the fashionable Bairro Alto and Chiado districts, or simply "shop until you drop." A traditional Fado show accompanies our farewell dinner. Fado is the musical expression of the Portuguese people, a melancholy set to a melody. The first fado singers, or "fadistas," were often the wives of fishermen who may or may not return from sea. We couldn't think of a more beautiful way to end our tour! B | D
