Trentham Gardens - Chester - Liverpool After a rich breakfast, we will depart Birmingham, and our first stop today is Trentham Gardens, a breathtaking estate in Staffordshire that blends historic charm



contemporary landscape Italian gardens, floral displays, and wooded areas are perfect for our serene walk. Next is Chester, a fabulous city covering almost 2,000 years of one of England's best-kept secrets. August 2, 2025 - Saturday

Liverpool

Highlights of this tour are the Childhood homes of The Beatles, Penny Lane and Strawberry Field, and Abbey Road Studios. Next, we will embark on a Liverpool city center walking tour to learn about the city's rich maritime history and cultural legacy. The remainder of the day is yours to shop, people-watch, and relax. August 3, 2025 - Sunday

The Cotswolds

After a rich breakfast, we will leave Liverpool and head towards fairy tale Cotswolds. Our first stop today is at Little Moreton Hall, a striking Tudor manor house renowned for its iconic timber-framed architecture. Its quirky, crooked appearance and intricate black-and-white patterns seem to defy gravity as it rises above a charming moat. We will explore the richly decorated rooms and learn about the fascinating history of the Moreton family, who lived there for centuries. Surrounded by picturesque gardens, the Hall offers a glimpse into England's Tudor



past and an unforgettable step back in time. Up next is Sudeley Castle. Playing a seminal role in England's extraordinary royal history and one-time home of Henry VIIIs widow, Catherine Parr, Sudeley Castle enjoys its reputation as one of the most breathtaking and instantly recognisable fortresses in England. We will take a stroll through the Castle's fabulous private apartments and discover its remarkable antiques and artworks. The real allure of Sudeley is surely its ten quintessentially English gardens, home to dazzling avenues of sculpted yews, an exquisite knot garden, and the intoxicating Queen's Garden, brimming with roses and once walked by no less than four English queens. And, of course, don't miss the infamous Sudeley pheasantry, home to one of the largest public collections of rare and endangered species of pheasants from around the world. We will stop for a leisurely lunch in the picturesque Burtonon-the-Water. Cameras out, everyone! The evening is yours to relax at our peaceful hotel, where dinner is served. B | D

August 4, 2025 - Monday

Woollen Weavers - Oxford - Bampton We will enjoy breakfast, and then visit Cotswold Woollen Weavers, a charming blend of history, craft, and tradition nestled in the heart of the Cotswolds. Celebrating over 300 years of woollen weaving heritage, the museum offers a fascinating glimpse into the region's rich textile history, showcasing the craftsmanship that made the Cotswolds famous for its wool. The shop is a treasure trove of beautifully woven goods, from traditional woollen blankets and scarves to contemporary designs, all made with locally sourced materials. Close by is Oxford, and we will immerse ourselves in its rich history during our walking tour. Oxford Castle and Prison is one of our stops, a historical site which can be traced back to the 11th century when a motte-and-bailey castle was constructed on the site. Over the centuries, the castle underwent various



renovations and expansions, becoming an important stronghold and royal residence. Free time for lunch. Ready for some Downton Abbey fun? Bampton, a village in Oxfordshire, served as one of the filming locations for the popular television series. Bampton was chosen for its well-preserved historic buildings and picturesque streets. See St. Mary's Church (the exterior was used as the Downton Abbey parish church, appearing in several wedding and funeral scenes), Bampton Library (served as the exterior Downton Cottage Hospital), and Churchgate House (a beautiful Georgian house, which as used as Isobel Crawley's home). After a beautiful day, we will return to our lovely hotel for dinner and an evening at leisure. B | D

August 5, 2025 - Tuesday

Lacock - Roman Bath

Breakfast is served at a slow pace this morning before we board our motor coach and continue our wonderful journey through the English countryside. We will stop to stroll Castle Combe, also known as "The Prettiest Village in England," and you will soon understand why. By the Middle Ages, the village in the valley had become an important center for the wool industry. The spinsters and weavers lived in the cottages, and the river, still known as By Brook, provided the power to run the mills. In recent times, the village has played host to many filming activities, the most famous being "Doctor Doolittle' filmed in and around the village in 1966. Have you ever heard about Lacock Abbey? This magnificent medieval monastery stands as a testament to centuries of history and architectural grandeur. Originally founded in the early 13th century, the abbey's imposing stone walls, intricate Gothic architecture, and tranquil cloisters offer a captivating journey through time. Renowned for its wellpreserved medieval interiors, including the impressive Chapter House and atmospheric cloisters, the abbey will take your breath



away. Our day ends in Bath, founded by the Romans as a thermal spa and an important center of the wool industry in the Middle Ages. The entire city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. Built above Bath's 115° hot springs around 70 AD, and today one of the best-preserved Roman remains in the world, the breathtaking Roman Baths is surely one of the thrilling highlights of our journey. Preserved within are its four main features, the Roman Temple, the Sacred Spring, the Roman Bath House, and a fabulous museum containing a remarkable collection of artifacts from Aquae Sulis. Check into our centrally located hotel for a peaceful evening. B

August 6, 2025 - Wednesday

Stonehenge/Avebury - Windsor - London Stone circle, manor house, museum, and modern village - it is hard to know where to begin your journey through the history of the utterly captivating Avebury, but one thing is for sure ... you won't leave here without wanting to return to this remarkable place! We will learn all about the magic of Avebury before we arrive in Windsor to explore and experience Windsor Castle, the largest occupied castle in the world; get ready for a grand day! Lunch is served in Windsor. In the late afternoon, we will check into our wonderful hotel in the heart of London. B | L

August 7, 2025 - Thursday

Royal Warrants - Shopping - Afternoon Tea This morning, you will discover the art of bespoke hand embroidery with a behind-the-scenes experience at Britain's oldest embroidery house on the Hand & Lock Studio Tour. Next, leisurely shopping at Liberty London, the world-renowned department store located in the heart of London's West End. The store is particularly famous for its fabrics and prints, which are designed inhouse and used in the store's own fashion and home collections. Our exciting day ends with an Afternoon Tea, a tradition dating back more than 200 years when, struck



by hunger pangs somewhere between lunch and dinner, the Duchess of Bedford invited her friends over for tea and "a light refreshment" in her rooms at Woburn Abbey. Word of her teatime innovation spread, and on her return to London, "Afternoon Tea" was deliciously inescapable. The remainder of the day is yours to enjoy London. B | AT

August 8, 2025 - Wednesday London

This morning, we will visit the Tower of London. Few parts of the UK are as steeped in legend, superstition, and extraordinary historical moments as the notorious Tower of London. But despite its grisly reputation as a place of torture and death, within its walls, you'll also discover the enthralling history of a royal palace, a working armory, treasury, and zoo - and the world's largest diamond, the 106-carat Koh-i-Nur, or "Mountain of Light." Join one of the legendary Beefeaters on a tour and hear their bloody tales; stand on the spot - if you dare! Next, we are off to visit the Fashion and Textile Museum, a vibrant hub dedicated to showcasing the creativity and history of fashion, textiles, and jewelry. The exhibitions cover a wide range of topics, from historical fashion trends to contemporary textile innovations and the works of influential designers. The afternoon is at leisure before we meet up to enjoy a dinner cruise, the most beautiful way to say a fond farewell to an incredible journey. B | D
