September 3, 2024 - Wednesday Arrival in Santiago de Chile

September 4, 2024 - Thursday Maipo Valley

After a leisurely breakfast, we drive to the stunning Maipo Valley. Maipo Valley's agriculture thrives thanks to its unique climate and fertile soils, making it one of Chile's top farming regions. The valley's irrigation system, fed by meltwater from the Andes, nourishes a variety of

crops. While wine grapes are the star of the region, especially Malbec, Maipo also grows olives, fruits, and vegetables. The region's rich soil and abundant sunshine create ideal conditions for high-quality produce, making it a key area for both wine and agricultural tourism. Today we visit Solar de Huidobro Orchard for a Marzipan workshop and gin pairing, enjoy the Boutique Winery Los Tres, and a fun and delicious Barbecue. Later in the day we return to Santiago's wonderful Bellavista neighborhood to explore the flavors, aromas, colors, and ingredients of Chile's ancestral culinary heritage at one of Santiago's best restaurants. This day promises to be a full day of visual and culinary delights! **B/L/D**

September 5, 2025 - Friday Santiago-Puerto Montt-Puerto Varas

This morning after breakfast we will head to the local Santiago Airport to board your flight... destination Puerto Montt. Upon arrival, meet the local guide and transfer to your hotel in Puerto Varas. Puerto Varas, located in southern Chile's Los Lagos Region, is a charming lakeside town known for its stunning natural beauty and outdoor adventures. Today we will visit a variety of farms that may include organic fruit, dairy production, chocolates, wineries, cideries, and breweries. A special private lunch at La Alazana Distillery a lovely family owned "farm distillery" is certain to be a highlight. After a full day of fun and adventure we will return to Bariloche for a lovely 3 course meal at a popular local restaurant. **B/L/D**

September 8, 2025 - Monday Bariloche Nature

Today we will have fun touring Bariloche's history and highlights.

This active excursion goes along the classic circuit of San Carlos de Bariloche. While visiting stunning viewpoints of the area, the guide will explain how this little mountain village has turned into one of the most attractive tourist towns in Patagonia.

We'll enjoy the beauty of Moreno and Nahuel Huapi lakes, as well as the Lopez and Capilla mountains. Continuing our day, we'll go for a nature-oriented walk through the Llao-Llao Nature Park to discover an impressive forest of Arrayanes trees. All of this will lead us to a delicious lunch and beer tasting at the Patagonia Microbrewery. The rest of your afternoon will be yours to create. Tonight we will dine together and enjoy an included glass of wine. **B/L/D**

September 9, 2025 - Tuesday Bariloche to Mar de Plata

After an early breakfast, we will transfer to the airport in Bariloche and fly to Buenos Aires. There we will meet our guide, board our private motorcoach, and head off to Mar del Plata with stops along the way including a lunch stop. Juan Ezcurra will join us. He is licensed in Agribusiness and a Special Consultant in cattle genetics with business in Argentina, Brazil and Uruguay. He will spend the next few days with us as we explore this area. Along the way we will visit a family owned Angus farm operation, La Pastoriza San Miguel del Monte. Today is a long travel day and the beginning of a deep dive into the agriculture of Argentina. Arrive at Mar de Plata for an overnight at the seaside beach hotel on Argentina's Atlantic coast. This will be the gateway to another level of agriculture this area offers. Upon arrival we will dine and discuss the fascinating days ahead of us. **B/L/D**

September 10, 2025 - Wednesday Mar de Plata

After a filling breakfast at the hotel we board our private motorcoach and head out for a full day of touring. Today, we'll dive deep into the intriguing business side of ranching in Argentina, where tradition meets cutting-edge innovation. This morning we will head south and stop to visit a farm that specializes in different types of crops. After breakfast we will begin our journey back to Buenos Aires. From the hotel we will travel 40 kilometers to visit El Volcan Ranch. This is a big operation featuring crops, cattle, irrigation and a cow-calf intensive production. We will have lunch on the ranch with Juan. After a full day of travel we will dine in style at a local gourmet restaurant in Buenos Aires with a glass of wine included.

All of these experiences are designed give you a unique perspective on the future of ranching, showcasing the perfect blend of tradition, technology, and business savvy that makes Argentina a world leader in agriculture. We hope you've enjoyed your exciting few days full of learning, innovation, and incredible insights into the ranching world!
