

overnight flight to London. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service; you are on your way to a dream destination!

June 23, 2025 - Monday London

Founded by the Romans over 2,000 years ago, the bustling metropolis of London straddles the murky Thames with a wealth of cultural diversity and over 300 spoken languages. Upon our arrival at Heathrow Airport, we will meet our tour guide, who will follow us throughout our journey. We are off to central London for a delightful brunch. Later, we will visit the incomparable Westminster, home of one of the world's most iconic Cathedrals and England's greatest building; the embodiment of the nation's history; theater of Kings and Queens and hallowed resting place of statesmen and soldiers; scientist, priests and poets, the magnificent Westminster Abbey welcomes over one million visitors every year - and little wonder! We continue to the Houses of Parliament before heading to one of the most visited landmarks in the city, Buckingham Palace (photo stop); if you look hard enough, you might just catch a glimpse of His Majesty at one of the palace's 760 windows ... Check into our hotel, relax, and unwind. B

June 24, 2025 - Tuesday

Kew Gardens - Kensington Palace We enjoy a hearty breakfast before

heading out to visit Kew Gardens (the Royal Botanic Gardens), London's largest UNESCO World Heritage site and home to tens of thousands of rare plant species,



immaculate gardens, and Britain's smallest royal palace. This is a journey through 250 years of botanical splendor. Explore the Gardens' magnificent glasshouses, from the tropical rainforests of the sensational Palm House to the recently restored Temperate House; experience life inside a real beehive in the "The Hive;" meander through the serene 17th-century Queen's Garden, and soak up the intoxicating scents of the fabulous Rose Garden, Lunch is served at a local restaurant before we continue to Kensington Palace. Kensington Palace remains home to members of the royal family, including TRH The Prince and Princess of Wales and their children, and was also the first marital home of The Duke and Duchess of Sussex. June 25, 2025 - Wednesday

Tower of London - West End Show

After an early breakfast, visit the Tower of London. Few parts of the UK are as steeped in legend, superstition, and extraordinary historical moments as the notorious Tower of London. But despite its grisly reputation as a place of torture and death, within its walls, you'll also discover the enthralling history of a royal palace, a working armory, treasury, and zoo - and the world's largest diamond, the 106-carat Koh-i-Nur, or "Mountain of Light." Join one of the legendary Beefeaters on a tour and hear their bloody tales; stand on the spot if you dare! We return to our hotel, and the rest of the day is yours to enjoy. Tonight, we will be amused during a pre-theater dinner and West End Show. B | D

June 26, 2025 - Thursday London at Leisure - Dinner Cruise



Breakfast at your own pace and a day at leisure to explore and find your favorite spot in London. Visit one of the trendy food markets, stroll Notting Hill and Portobello market, Primrose Hill and Camden Town market, Greenwich Village with the Royal Observatory, Victoria and Albert Museum with its extraordinary fashion, theater, and jewelry galleries (and the best museum shop in the entire UK!), or simply "shop till you drop." Your Oyster Card (public transportation card) makes it easy and fast to navigate around. Tonight's dinner cruise is a beautiful way to say a fond goodbye to this stunning city. B | D

June 27, 2025 - Friday

Windsor Castle - JFK Memorial - Burnham We depart London this morning. Nestled in the spectacular Berkshire landscape, atop a crag one hundred feet above the river Thames sits the inimitable Windsor Castle, the largest occupied castle in the world. Step inside to explore Windsor's intriguing history, from the perfectly magnificent State Rooms adorned with exquisite tapestries, wood carvings, and artworks by Rubens and Rembrandt to Queen Mary's Dolls House. There is also the breathtaking architecture of St George's Chapel - home to Britain's oldest order of Knights, the wedding venue of Harry and Meghan, and the resting place of no less than ten Kings of England. Leisurely lunch in Windsor before we stop at the Runnymede JFK Memorial. It commemorates the visit of President John F. Kennedy to the United Kingdom in June 1963. The site holds significance as it is also the location where the Magna Carta, a historical document that laid the foundation for modern democratic principles and human rights, was sealed by King John of



England in 1215. We will enjoy our evening in Burnham, where our hotel is nestled within the Burnham Beeches Nature Reserve, a beautiful area known for its ancient woodland and scenic landscapes. Dinner at our hotel. B | D

June 28, 2025 - Saturday Downton Abbey Theme Day - Oxford

The theme of the day, Ladies: Downton Abbey! Though we cannot guarantee tickets to Highclere Castle*, what we can guarantee is a day you will never forget! The nearby village of Bampton served as one of the major filming locations and was chosen for its well-preserved historic buildings and picturesque streets. Some of the notable filming locations include St. Mary's Church; the exterior was used as the Downton Abbey parish church and appeared in several wedding and funeral scenes. Bampton Library served as the exterior of the Downton Cottage Hospital. Bampton Village Hall was transformed into the interior of the cottage hospital for filming. Churchgate House, a beautiful Georgian house, was used as Isobel Crawley's home, known as Crawley House, in the show. And finally, the Old Grammar School, which was used as the exterior of Downton Abbey's schoolhouse. We will enjoy lunch at a local pub, and before heading to our hotel, we stop at CogCogges Manor Farm. The farm has a history dating back over 1,000 years and is known for its well-preserved medieval manor house, tearoom, and gift shop, where you can purchase local produce, crafts, and souvenirs. We arrive in Oxford in the late afternoon. A city of Dreaming Spires, a sublime ensemble of worldly wonders, and a world-class hub



of noteworthy innovation. Oxford surely ranks amongst England's most beautiful cities - prepare to be besotted! B | L *Can be confirmed in October 2024.

June 29, 2025 - Sunday Oxford - Bath

The day is dedicated to Oxford! We will walk Radcliffe Square, explore the city's magnificent University colleges, and visit the stunning Christ Church Cathedral with its dual role as a cathedral and college chapel. Lunch is served in Oxford before visiting the Botanic Garden, the United Kingdom's oldest, with its delightful walled garden, beautiful glasshouses, and fabulous Arboretum. Our day ends in Bath, founded by the Romans as a thermal spa and an important center of the wool industry in the Middle Ages. The entire city is a UNESCO World Heritage Site. B | L

June 30, 2025 - Monday Bath

Built above Bath's 115° hot springs around 70AD, and today one of the best-preserved Roman remains in the world, the breathtaking Roman Baths is surely one of the thrilling highlights of our journey. Preserved within are its four main features, the Roman Temple, the Sacred Spring, the Roman Bath House, and а fabulous museum containing remarkable collection а of artifacts from Aquae Sulis. The afternoon is yours to enjoy. Swing by the Guildhall Market, the oldest shopping venue in the city, with more than twenty stallholders selling pretty souvenirs. Or, enjoy your afternoon tea by the Pulteney Bridge. We gather tonight to enjoy dinner at a restaurant in Bath. B | D



July 1, 2025 - Tuesday Arundel Castle - Tunbridge Wells

After a delicous brekfast, we are off to Arundel Castle. The Castle is home to the Duke of Norfolk, reflecting nearly 1,000 years of history and commanding the surrounding landscape with magnificent views (cover page photo!). Fine furniture and works of art in sumptuously furnished rooms and spectacular gardens! Our lunch is local, and we will reach Tunbridge Wells in the afternoon.
