Important notes about seat assignments, upgrades, TSA Pre-Check- & Frequent Flyer Numbers:

- Group airfare comes with seat assignments 30 days prior to departure. We cannot confirm precise seat numbers earlier than 30 days prior to your departure and therefore cannot guarantee the availability of specific seating on the aircraft. We do our best to honor your preferences (window, aisle seat).
- **Premium seating upgrades - depending on availabilities:**
Economy Plus can be purchased and confirmed once the tickets are issued = 30 days prior to departure. Estimate a supplement of \$200-400.
Premium Economy and Business Class can be reserved at the time of booking your trip with us. Please reach out to us for your personal quote. Not all flights offer Premium Economy and Business Class.
- **Mileage credit** for individuals on group air contracts, *your account number is required at the time of reservation*. Once a flight departs, you must go to the airline website directly to provide them with your flight details. This can take 4-8 weeks to complete. We can not use mileage points for seat upgrades or ticketing.
- **TSA Pre-Check numbers and Frequent Flyer numbers** must be reported at the time of check-in at your local airport on the days of departure.
