March 24, 2026 - Tuesday

Edmonston - Charleston - Sightseeing-Alston House

This morning, set out on a captivating Charleston City Tour. Perched on a scenic peninsula, Charleston has flourished as a charming port city for more than 300 years. Its historic charm and Southern elegance are woven into everyday life. Explore highlights like the Historic District, The Citadel, and the storied Battery Park.

Then step inside the Edmonston-Alston House. Despite the turmoil of the Civil War, the 1886 Earthquake, and countless hurricanes, the home's treasures remain remarkably intact. Among them: an original Ordinance of Secession print, striking portraits, a stately dining table, glowing gas lamps, antique mirrors, and intricate woodwork. This evening, share a Welcome Dinner with your fellow travelers at one of Charleston's beloved local restaurants. B/D

March 25, 2026 - Wednesday

Charleston - Beaufort - Savannah

Today, stroll through the breathtaking grounds of Middleton Place, home to America's oldest landscaped gardens and a National Historic Landmark. Begun in 1741, it took ten years to sculpt the terraced lawns, shimmering lakes, and fragrant camellia alleys. Tour the stately home and visit the stable yard, alive with the sounds and sights of traditional craft demonstrations.

Then travel to Beaufort, a coastal gem founded in 1711, where moss-draped oaks line quiet streets and centuries-old homes glow in the Southern sun. Savor a scenic Carriage Ride through this charming town. Continue to Savannah, where brick-lined squares, ironwork balconies, and over 1,000 restored buildings make the city's historic heart a living museum. Settle in for a two-night stay and enjoy a relaxed evening exploring local flavors or unique shops. B/D

March 26, 2026 - Thursday

Savannah Sightseeing

This morning, step into Southern intrigue at the beautifully restored Mercer-Williams House Museum, designed by New York architect John S. Norris for General Hugh W. Mercer.

Construction began in 1860, paused by the Civil War, and was completed in 1868.

Then set out on a guided Savannah City Tour. Discover 20 enchanting squares, each draped in live oaks, blooming azaleas, graceful fountains, and historic statues. Pass by the Old Cotton Exchange, River Street, and Madison Square—scenes rich with echoes of General Sherman's infamous March to the Sea.

This afternoon, enjoy time at your own pace. Follow the footsteps of Midnight in the Garden of Good and Evil through moss-hung avenues and along cobblestone streets. This evening, gather with fellow travelers for a memorable dinner featuring Lowcountry flavors at one of Savannah's fine local restaurants. B

March 27, 2026 - Friday

Savannah - St. Simons Island - Jekyll Island

Today, journey south to Georgia's Golden Isles, where salt-kissed breezes and moss-draped oaks welcome you. Explore St. Simons Island, known for its serene marshlands and sunlit beaches. Visit the iconic Christ Church and the historic St. Simons Lighthouse—originally lost to the Civil War and beautifully rebuilt in 1872.

This afternoon, arrive on Jekyll Island, once a secluded retreat for America's wealthiest families. Names like Goodyear, Pulitzer, and Rockefeller left their mark in the form of grand "cottages" tucked beneath ancient oaks. Settle in for a two-night stay at the legendary Jekyll Island Club, a majestic 1886 Victorian hotel that once hosted the Gilded Age elite. B

March 28, 2026 - Saturday

Jekyll Island

This morning, step aboard a guided Jekyll Island Trolley Tour through the island's storied historic district. Visit the elegant Indian Mound Cottage, explore the interactive Mosaic Gallery, and admire the stained glass beauty of Faith Chapel.

Spend your afternoon at leisure—wander along the beach, relax beneath swaying palms, or enjoy the peaceful charm of the resort grounds. This evening, gather for a memorable Farewell Dinner in the Grand Dining Room of the Jekyll Island Club—a timeless venue that has hosted industry magnates, stage legends, and distinguished guests for more than a century. B/D

March 29, 2026 - Sunday

Jekyll Island - Jacksonville - Traveling Home

Today, bid farewell to the golden shores of Jekyll Island as you journey to Jacksonville for your flight home. 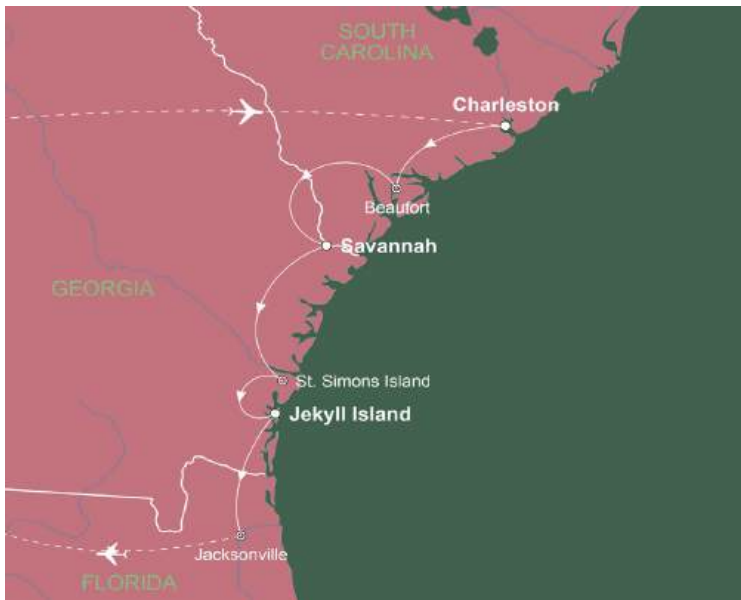

Important notes about seat assignments, upgrades, TSA Pre-Check- & Frequent Flyer Numbers:

- Group airfare comes with **seat assignments 30 days prior to departure**. We cannot confirm precise seat numbers earlier than 30 days prior to your departure and therefore cannot guarantee the availability of specific seating on the aircraft. We do our best to honor your preferences (window, aisle seat).
- **Premium seating upgrades - depending on availabilities:**
Economy Plus can be purchased and confirmed **once the tickets are issued** = 30 days prior to departure. Estimate a supplement of \$600-\$900.
Premium Economy can be reserved **at the time of booking** your trip with us. Estimate a supplement of \$2,000-\$3,000.
Business Class can be reserved **at the time of booking** your trip with us. Estimate a supplement of \$4,000-\$6,000.
- **Mileage credit:** If you have a frequent flyer account and provide the number before departure, you will receive mileage credit automatically for flights with that carrier. If the account is added during travel or after you return, you will need to submit your boarding passes directly to the carrier to claim the credit.
