

Traveling to England

Our wonderful adventure begins as we meet at Omaha Airport* to take an overnight flight to London. Enjoy in-flight entertainment and meal service as you start your dream vacation. April 16, 2026 - Thursday

London

Upon our arrival at Heathrow Airport, we will meet our tour guide, who will follow us throughout our journey. We are off to central London for a delightful brunch. Founded by the Romans over 2,000 years ago, the bustling metropolis of London straddles the murky Thames with a wealth of cultural diversity and over 300 spoken languages. London

April 20, 2026 - Monday

Windsor - Stonehenge - Bath

We will depart London this morning. Nestled in the spectacular Berkshire landscape, atop a crag one hundred feet above the River Thames, sits the inimitable Windsor Castle, the largest occupied castle in the world. Step inside to explore Windsor's intriguing history, from the perfectly magnificent State Rooms adorned with exquisite tapestries, wood carvings, and artworks by Rubens and Rembrandt to Queen Mary's Dolls House. There is also the breathtaking architecture of St George's Chapel - home to Britain's oldest order of Knights, the wedding venue of Harry and Meghan, and the resting place of no less than ten Kings of England. Lunch is served in a local pub before we continue to Stonehenge. Step back in time to one of the world's most famous prehistoric monuments. Marvel at the towering stone circle, discover its ancient origins and explore the myths and legends surrounding this UNESCO World Heritage Site. April 22, 2026 - Wednesday

Castle Combe - A Vineyard - Broadway Today, we will immerse ourselves deeper into The Cotswolds. Our first stop is at the enchanting Lacock Abbey, a stunning medieval abbey-turned-country house with a rich history and picturesque surroundings. We will wander through its historic cloisters, made famous by Harry Potter films. Next, we will stop to stroll Castle Combe, also known as "The Prettiest Village in England," and you will soon understand why. By the Middle Ages, the village in the valley had become an important center for the wool industry. The spinsters and weavers lived in the cottages, and the river, still known as By Brook, provided the power to run the mills. Recently, the village has played host to many filming activities, the most famous being "Doctor Doolittle' filmed in and around the village in 1966. Free time for lunch before we continue to a local vineyard situated on the edge of Tetbury. We will enjoy the beautiful views of the rolling Cotswold landscape and a savory snack. We will check into our fairy tale hotel on Broadway in the afternoon. B | S



April 23, 2026 - Thursday

More of The Cotswolds

Sudeley Castle is Grade 1 listed and has ten notable gardens covering some fifteen acres within a 1,200-acre estate. We will walk in the footsteps of some of history's most notable characters in the beautiful gardens. It is also the only private castle in England to have a gueen buried within its grounds. The Queens' Garden is the magnificent centerpiece of Sudeley's gardens. It is named after four of England's queens: Anne Boleyn, Katherine Parr, Lady Jane Grey, and Elizabeth I. In Tudor times, it would have been planted with herbs, vegetables, and decorative flowers. Today, it boasts more than eighty varieties of roses. Next, we will also make a photo stop in Bourton-on-the-Water and take a short walking tour of Stow-on-the-Wold. A traditional Afternoon Tea is served in a beautilful tea room, and our last stop is at a historic, family-run brewery in the heart of the Cotswolds. Established in 1849, it combines heritage brewing methods with modern innovation. We will enjoy a pint of award-winning ale brewed with passion and tradition! Time to relax tonight. B | T | T

April 24, 2026 - Friday

Porcelain - Beatles - Liverpool

On our way to Liverpool, we will stop at the renowned Wedgwood Factory. This is a unique and immersive experience in the world of fine ceramics, showcasing the Wedgwood's craftsmanship, innovation, and rich heritage, a brand founded by Josiah Wedgwood in 1759. Next, get ready for Beatles-town, Liverpool! Upon our arrival, we will visit the world's largest permanent exhibition solely devoted to the legendary story of the Fab Four's rise to fame, the wonderful and award-winning Beatles Story Museum.
