Tuesday - March 10, 2026

Arrival in Lima, Peru

After a long day of travel we arrive in the beautiful and exotic city of Lima, Peru and transfer to our 4 star accommodations in the lovely neighborhood of Miraflores. Miraflores is Lima's vibrant coastal district known for its upscale shops, lush parks, and stunning ocean views. Welcome to paradise!

Wednesday - March 11, 2026

Visit to the Larco Museum and a Free Afternoon

We'll begin our day with a visit to the renowned Larco Museum, home to the world's largest collection of pre-Columbian jewelry once worn by ancient Peruvian rulers. Explore intricate gold crowns, ear spools, masks, and ceremonial vessels adorned with semiprecious stones. With over 10,000 years of history thoughtfully displayed across Peru's diverse regions—from the North Coast to the Andes—this museum offers a fascinating look into the country's rich cultural past. Afterward, we'll enjoy a delicious lunch at an oceanfront restaurant, where you can relax and take in the coastal views. The afternoon is yours to spend at your leisure—whether that means shopping for local treasures or simply unwinding in beautiful surroundings. B/L

Thursday - March 12, 2026 Half-day city tour and waterfall park

Begin your Peruvian adventure with a captivating half-day city tour that blends the charm of modern Lima with its rich historical roots. Explore the vibrant district of Miraflores, where oceanfront parks overlook the Pacific, and take in breathtaking coastal views. Journey back in time at pre-Columbian archaeological sites like Huaca Pucllana, a striking adobe pyramid nestled in the heart of the city. Then, head to Lima's historic center—a UNESCO World Heritage Site—where colonial-era architecture, grand plazas, and centuries-old cathedrals reveal the city's storied past. This engaging introduction offers a perfect snapshot of Lima's culture, history, and scenic beauty.

This evening, enjoy a stunning welcome presentation at the magical Water Fountain Park, Parque de las Aguas, where illuminated waterfalls and dancing lights set the stage for your journey ahead. This unforgettable show will introduce the rich culture, landscapes, and wonders you'll experience throughout your week in Peru. **B**

Friday - March 13, 2026

Flight from Lima to Cusco - Sacred Valley Sunset
We've arranged your flight from Lima to Cusco, taking you

from the coast to the majestic Andes at an altitude of 3,350 meters above sea level. To help your body adjust gradually to the elevation, we'll drive straight from the airport to your hotel in the Sacred Valley, where you'll have a free afternoon to relax and begin a gentle acclimatization. This peaceful setting is the perfect starting point for the exciting high-altitude adventures awaiting you in the coming days. **B/D**

Saturday - March 14, 2026

Tour to Machu Picchu from Sacred Valley

Your day begins early with a transfer from your hotel to the Ollantaytambo train station, followed by a scenic two-hour train ride to Aguas Calientes. Upon arrival, you'll have some time to enjoy breakfast or explore the town before boarding the bus to Machu Picchu, taking in breathtaking views along the way.

At Machu Picchu, enjoy a 2.5-hour guided tour through this awe-inspiring Incan citadel, one of the New Seven Wonders of the World. Your expert guide will lead you through iconic sites such as the Guardian's House, the Intihuatana (solar clock), the Temple of the Condor, and other sacred spaces. After the tour, you'll have free time to explore and take photos on your own.

Later, return by bus to Aguas Calientes for lunch, and if time allows, relax in the local thermal baths. In the afternoon, board the train back to Ollantaytambo and continue by car to your accommodation in the Sacred Valley. **B/L/D**

Sunday - March 15, 2026

Cultural immersion - Meet a local family at Willog


Immerse yourself in authentic Andean culture with a memorable visit to the Willoq community, where breathtaking landscapes meet living Inca traditions. Take part in ancestral activities like spinning and weaving, share a delicious pachamanca meal cooked underground, and join in the joyful rhythms of the traditional Huallata dance. This enriching experience offers a deep connection to the history, nature, and enduring customs of the Andes.

In the afternoon, we journey toward Cusco with a brief stop at the stunning salt mines of Maras—a striking landscape of pink and white salt terraces, still harvested today using ancient

techniques passed down through generations. We end the day in Cusco, nestled at 3,350 meters above sea level, where the city's magical streets echo the legacy of the Inca Empire. B/L

Monday - March 16, 2026

Free morning in Cusco and city tour

Today is dedicated to immersing yourself in the rich culture and ancient history of Cusco, the former capital of the Inca Empire. We'll begin with a guided walk around the main square before heading into the surrounding hills for panoramic views and a deeper understanding of the city's famed heritage. Highlights include visits to the Sun Temple (Qoricancha), the impressive stone fortress of Sacsayhuamán, the ceremonial site of Qengo, and the water temple of Tambomachay.

This tour may be scheduled for either the morning or afternoon, and you will have free time to explore Cusco's vibrant streets, local markets, and hidden corners at your own pace. B

Tuesday - March 17, 2026

Fly from Cusco to Puerto Maldonado - Rainforest Sunsets After breakfast, we transfer to the Cusco airport for a flight to Puerto Maldonado, the gateway to Peru's lush Amazon rainforest and the Tambopata National Reserve. Upon arrival, we travel by boat down the scenic Madre de Dios River—an unforgettable 1.5-hour journey into the heart of the jungle—to reach the welcoming Ecolucerna Lodge.

After a delicious lunch made with organic, locally sourced ingredients, we'll set out to explore the surrounding rainforest. Learn about the unique ecosystems of both primary and secondary forests, their natural resources, and their vital role in the planet's health. As the day ends, enjoy a special night excursion by boat along the river to discover the nocturnal life and secrets of the Amazon under the stars. B/L/D

Wednesday - March 18, 2026

Expedition to Sandoval Lake - Safari tonight!

Today promises to be an unforgettable adventure filled with the sights and sounds of the Amazon. We'll hike through the Tambopata National Reserve to reach the serene Sandoval Lake, a protected haven for incredible wildlife such as the endangered giant river otter, the vibrant blue-and-yellow macaw, and the massive paiche, one of the world's largest freshwater fish. Enjoy a peaceful picnic on the lake surrounded by nature, with time to relax before heading back to the lodge.

After a well-deserved rest, we'll head out once more for a guided night walk, flashlights in hand, to discover the Amazon's fascinating nocturnal wildlife. We end this amazing day with a farewell dinner of freshly steamed fish wrapped in banana leaves, prepared in true traditional Amazonian style. B/L/D

Thursday - March 19, 2026

Meeting indigenous local families - Flight to Lima

This morning offers a peaceful moment to enjoy the sunrise and take in the breathtaking views of the Madre de Dios River one last time. Savor a final nutritious breakfast made with fresh, organic ingredients from the lodge's own pantry.

Before your departure, your guide and the Ecolucerna staff will bid you farewell and share a brief presentation on the inspiring work of the Green Angels Foundation and their efforts in rainforest conservation. Then, we travel by canoe back to Puerto Maldonado, followed by a transfer to the airport for our return flight to Lima, closing this unforgettable journey through Peru's natural and cultural wonders. B/L

Friday - March 20, 2026

Bidding farewell

Today marks the closing chapter of your grand Peruvian adventure, a journey woven with vibrant colors, ancient whispers, and breathtaking landscapes.
