


In addition, a native New Yorker will share history as well as personal insight into life in NYC.

November 18, 2026 Wednesday

Our wonderful journey begins as we fly to the Big Apple, New York City.

Upon arrival, we will be greeted by our local New York City tour guide, who will introduce us to the Big Apple.

We arrive at LaGuardia Airport, and then our motor coach will whisk us off to Manhattan, where we will begin a panoramic city tour of the Big Apple. Our native New Yorker guide will introduce us to some of the city's splendors, and we'll get our first glimpse of the Statue of Liberty and walk Ground Zero.



Check into Millennium Broadway Hotel, a deluxe hotel located right in the heart of the theatre district. Time to relax and enjoy your first New York-style dinner (pastrami on rye, anyone?)

If you are still awake, join Morrie for a subway ride to the Staten Island Ferry for beautiful views of Manhattan and the Statue of Liberty. The evening skyline of Manhattan is unequaled by any other city in the world (weather permitting).

Boxed lunch is included today.

November 19, 2026 Thursday

Time to enjoy your breakfast.

At 10:00 AM, join Morrie for a walking tour of the theatre district. He'll share funny stories of Broadway divas, hits and flops, and even throw in some ghost stories (all true!).

The remainder of the day is for leisure. You are in the heart of Manhattan Midtown, and the opportunities for sightseeing are endless. You can utilize your MetroCard to move around; the Subway is a great and fast way to navigate through the city.

Tonight, you will take a short walk to your first Broadway show (you will be able to choose approximately 120 days before departure).

Breakfast is included today.

November 20, 2026 Friday

Breakfast is enjoyed at your own pace.

At 10:00 AM, join Morrie on a walking tour of Grand Central Terminal and the New York Public Library.

At Grand Central, Morrie will take you to the Whispering Gallery and show you where a missile was displayed in the middle of the commuter congestion. A quick jaunt down the block takes you to the beloved library, where you can see the original stuffed animals that inspired the Winnie-the-Pooh stories.

Morrie will lead the group back to the hotel.

The rest of the day is free at leisure. This is a good time to take the ferry to the Statue of Liberty/Ellis Island (note if you want to go into pedestal or crown you need to make advance reservations).

The Museum of Modern Art (MOMA) is within walking distance and features immortal works from van Gogh to Warhol.

For shoppers, there is 5th Avenue shopping or you can head to The Meatpacking District with the Chelsea Market and designer shops. It is possible to take a scroll back from here to the hotel via the High Line, a unique park built on an old railroad line. Once destined for demolition, luckily, the community rallied together to repurpose it instead, creating the park you can experience today. But the







High Line is more than a park - it is a public space where you can view art, walk through gardens, savor delicious snacks, or just people-watch, while enjoying a unique perspective of the city. Built on the historic, elevated freight line, the High Line is really a wonderful place to stroll. To walk the entire length (1.45 miles) takes around 30 minutes.

Tonight, a short walk from the hotel will take you to your second Broadway show of your own choice. We will notify you of your options approximately 120 days before departure.

Breakfast is included today.

November 21, 2026 Saturday

Enjoy breakfast with your fellow travelers.

At 10:00 AM, we will take a short walk to Radio City Music Hall - the greatestshowplace on Earth with jaw-dropping gorgeous architecture. It is also the home to the Rockettes, superstars, and camels! Upon opening its doors for the first time on a rainy winter's night in 1932, the Radio City Music Hall was proclaimed to be so extraordinarily beautiful as to need no performers at all. The first-built component of the massive Rockefeller Center, the Music Hall, has been the world's largest indoor theater for over eighty years. We will experience the Spectacular

Christmas Show.

After the end of the show, stroll back towards the hotel or continue exploring the neighborhood around Radio City. We are just around the corner from St. Patrick's Cathedral. Join Morrie as he visits the Neo-Gothic-style Roman cathedral, a prominent landmark of New York City.

The remainder of the afternoon is at leisure.

Tonight, we meet for a fun farewell dinner at a nearby famous restaurant. Cheers to our group and the greatest bite of the Big Apple!

Breakfast and dinner are included today.

November 22, 2026 Sunday

Breakfast is served, and then a morning free to do some last-minute shopping or grab a last bite at one of the fun delis. Check-out time is 11:00 AM, but the hotel will safely store your luggage away until we depart for the airport.
