Vienna

November 30, 2026 - Monday

Vienna

After a hearty breakfast, we are ready for city sightseeing on foot, including visiting the Christmas markets in Vienna. This morning, we will explore the Christmas markets of Vienna. These markets are age-old traditions, with origins of present-day events dating

back to the Middle Ages when, in 1298, Albrecht I granted the citizens of Vienna the privilege of holding a “Krippenmarkt” (Crib Market). Our first stop is the Christmas market in front of the City Hall. The unique backdrop gives this market its own charm! We will continue on foot to the Christmas market at Stephansplatz, which features more than 30 stalls focusing on high-quality local products. There will be free time for lunch before we walk back to our hotel. A guided tour of the world-famous Sisi Museum is scheduled for later in the day. Dinner and an evening at leisure are planned (Optional: your tour guide will arrange a classical concert on the spot). B

December 1, 2026 - Tuesday

Vienna

After breakfast, we head out to visit Schönbrunn Palace. During the reign of Maria Theresa (1740-1780), Schönbrunn became the dazzling center of court life. From that time onward, it hosted the leading statesmen of Europe. Emperor Franz Joseph and his wife Sisi had a total of 1,441 rooms at Schönbrunn Palace. We will have the opportunity to explore many of these luxurious rooms and immerse ourselves directly in the imperial era. Next, enjoy a demonstration of apple strudel—and a tasting, of course. In the afternoon, we will visit the Imperial Treasury, just a short walk from our hotel. The evening is yours to enjoy at leisure. B | T

December 2, 2026 - Wednesday

Melk Abbey - Salzburg

Breakfast is served at a leisurely pace.

We board our motorcoach for a brief one-hour drive to Melk Abbey. Rising high above the town of Melk on a rocky outcrop overlooking the Danube, the bright yellow Benedictine abbey houses the tomb of Saint Coloman of Stockerau and the remains of several members of the House of Babenberg - Austria’s first ruling dynasty. The library is one of its most impressive features, boasting roughly 100,000 volumes and a ceiling fresco by Paul Troger. A beautiful church and several important paintings await discovery, but the true treasures are the two Melk Crucifixes, one believed to contain a piece of Christ’s cross. Our journey continues to Salzburg, where we will enjoy a leisurely lunch along our scenic route. We will arrive at our centrally located hotel in the afternoon for an evening at leisure. B | L

December 3, 2026 - Thursday

Salzburg

Breakfast is served, and then we will set out for a walking tour of Old Town Salzburg, the hometown of Wolfgang Amadeus. We will explore the Residence, St. Peter’s Monastery, the Festival House, and the Rock Riding School. We will also attend a beautiful 30-minute concert at the Salzburg Cathedral and visit Mirabell Gardens. In the afternoon, it’s time for Mozart! We will visit the “Geburtshaus,” the house where Mozart was born in 1756 and lived with his parents until 1773. The house has now been transformed into a three-floor exhibit showcasing Mozart’s life: his upbringing, his beginnings in music, his friends and patrons, family relationships, his passion for opera, and much more. You will have free time to

relationships, his passion for opera, and much more. You will have free time to enjoy this captivating and enchanting city by night. Salzburg will take your breath away; it truly is one of the most beautiful cities in Europe. (Optional: a classical concert will be arranged by your tour guide on the spot). B

December 4, 2026 - Friday

Salzburg - Oberndorf Chapel
After a delicious breakfast, we will board our motorcoach and let ourselves be carried away, following in the footsteps of the Trapp family and humming to the tunes of "The Sound of Music!" We will visit Oberndorf Chapel, the birthplace of the famous Christmas carol "Silent Night, Holy Night." Then, we will return to Salzburg to explore the charming town and all it has to offer! B

December 5, 2026 - Saturday

Salzburg
More "The Sound of Music" awaits as we head out to visit Mondsee (and stop by the "wedding church"). We will visit the village of St. Wolfgang, where we will enjoy lunch. Afterward, we will take a boat tour to St. Gilgen, known for its baroque Advent market, before continuing on to Hellbrunn Palace and the Hellbrunner Advent Magic, where the palace's façade transforms into a massive Advent calendar, with its 24 windows marking the countdown to Christmas. Over 700 conifers adorned with 10,000 red baubles and twinkling lights create a magical forest setting that illuminates the grounds. The evening is at your leisure, and your tour guide is happy to suggest great places for dinner. B | L

December 6, 2026 - Sunday

Oberammergau - Munich
After breakfast, we are ready to depart Salzburg and head toward Munich. On the way, we will stop in Oberammergau. You will enjoy this town, famous for its Passion Play performances that take place every ten years. The area is known for its woodcarvers, and you'll find numerous shops dedicated to this beautiful craft. Many carvings beautifully depict biblical figures, angels, Madonnas, and nativity scenes, all in harmony with religious themes. We will enjoy lunch in Oberammergau before continuing to Linderhof Palace, which is beautifully set on the edge of the Bavarian Alps. It's hard to imagine a better backdrop. Of the three palaces built by the "mad" King Ludwig II (Hohenschwangau, Neuschwanstein, and Linderhof), this was the only one he saw completed. We will reach Munich in the afternoon and check in to our hotel in the center of town. In the evening, we have arranged a walking tour to the nearby old-town Christmas market at Marienplatz, featuring the world-famous Glockenspiel. B | L

December 7, 2026 - Monday

Regensburg
After a hearty breakfast, we will drive to Regensburg, a medieval UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Germany's oldest towns. Crusaders crossed the Danube via the 12th-century stone bridge on their way to the Holy Land. We have arranged an old-town sightseeing tour on foot, and we will visit the Christmas market at the Thurn & Taxis Palace. During Advent, the courtyard transforms into a magical stage for one of Bavaria's most beautiful

Christmas markets. Anyone hungry? Enjoy lunch at the historic "Wurstkuchl" (Sausage Kitchen). Housed in a 900-year-old building, this is the world's oldest sausage kitchen, still serving over 6,000 sausages daily. Our final stop is at a local hat maker, where we will see and learn the techniques behind some of the most elegant hats you can imagine. The quality is the finest you can find! We will return to our hotel in Munich in the late afternoon. B

December 8, 2026 - Tuesday

Munich
We begin our day by admiring the world-famous collection of nativity scenes at the Bayerisches National Museum. After that, we will visit the Residenz Christmas market. The organizers have recreated a Christmas market in the Emperor's Court, the former Bavarian seat of government. Tonight, we have arranged a farewell dinner at a special restaurant. "Prost" (cheers) to our wonderful group! B | D
